RE: Mediterranean Shipping Takes Advantage of IANA's New Street Interchange Application

This is to advise that UIIA Equipment Provider, Mediterranean Shipping will begin handling all street interchange/street turn requests via IANA's new Street Interchange Application. **Effective September 19, 2016, all Motor Carriers wishing to initiate a street interchange or street turn request involving Mediterranean Shipping equipment will be required to do so through IANA's Street Interchange Application.**

Motor Carriers may access IANA's Street Interchange Application via link on navigation bar once logged into their UIIA account or by going directly to www.streetinterchange.com and using their UIIA credentials to log into the system. The new application provides an efficient method for UIIA participants to facilitate the street interchange process. Features of the system include:

- Captures electronically the transfer of liability, damage and indemnification set forth under the UIIA from the originating Motor Carrier to the receiving Motor Carrier when street interchange is performed.
- Provides automatic validation to confirm that the receiving Motor Carrier has a valid UIIA interchange with the UIIA Equipment Provider(s) involved in the street interchange transaction.
- Interfaces with IANA's Global Intermodal Equipment Registry (GIER) application to confirm the SCAC Code for the chassis Equipment Provider so the interchange status between the Motor Carrier and the chassis provider can also be validated (as long as the chassis EP is a UIIA participant).
- Provides access to supporting documentation related to the street interchange transaction to all involved parties, which can be of assistance in cases of disputes. In addition, this documentation will enable EPs to properly allocate free time and per diem based on terms contained in their individual UIIA addendum as well as maintenance and repair charges.
