

If your company is wanting to do business with **Amazon** (www.Relay.Amazon.com), and you are currently **NOT** registered with UIIA, you will need to register and get set up with the following UIIA Equipment Providers:

- BNSF
- CMA-CGM
- COSCO
- CSX Intermodal
- Evergreen Shipping
- Flexi-Van Leasing
- Hapag Lloyd
- HMM
- Maersk
- Norfolk Southern
- Ocean Network Express (ONE)
- OOCL
- Union Pacific
- Yang Ming Marine
- ZIM

You will be required to have:

- Active US DOT Number and MC Number with FMCSA.
- Active Standard Carrier Alpha Code (SCAC) with NMFTA.
- Federal Tax Identification Number.
- You will be required to pay the [UIIA annual fee](#).

If your company has insurance with:

Progressive Insurance – This insurance company normally will not write the required UIIA auto liability policy so Motor Carriers having this insurance company will need to work with their agent to find an insurance carrier that will provide the required UIIA coverage.

Knight's Specialty Insurance – The agent will be required to provide confirmation directly from Knights Specialty that the policy has the required hired autos and that the UIIE-1 or CA23-17 endorsement is on the policy.

Amazon is NOT a UIIA Equipment Provider. However, **Amazon** does receive updates from the UIIA office once a day at 11:00 a.m. (EDT) on Motor Carrier status information. The updates will usually take up to 48 hours for the information to be posted in **Amazon's** Relay system.

IANA does not set your company up with work with **Amazon**. You would need to check the **Amazon** Relay Load Board or contact **Amazon** directly for instructions on how to arrange work.
